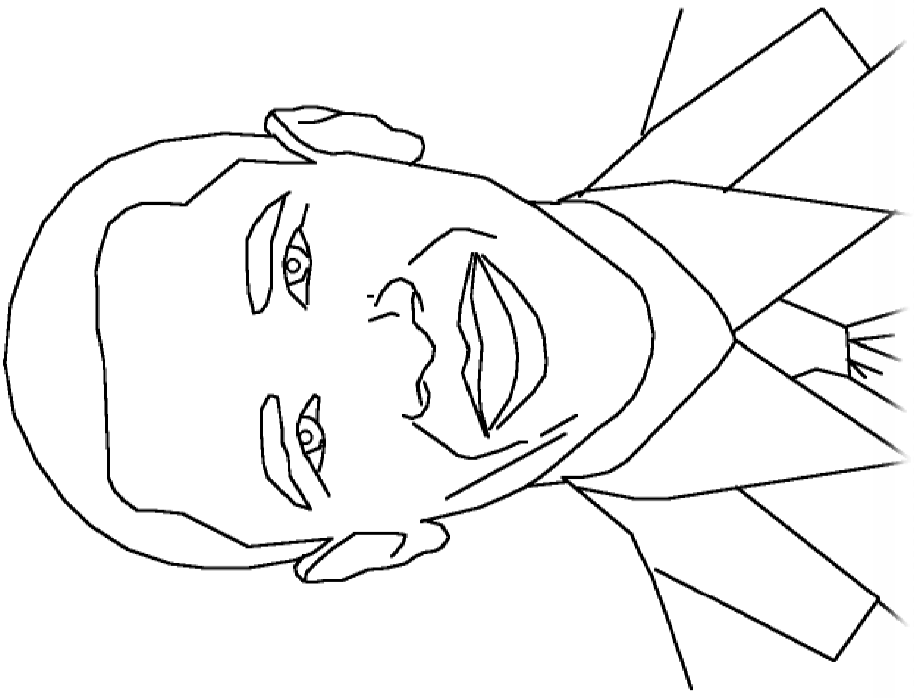


THE LINE OF BARACK OBAMA'S LIFE
