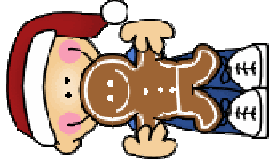


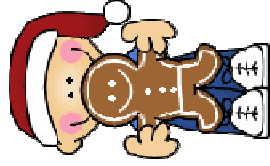
December Task Card #1

Write an acrostic poem using the word DECEMBER. After you are finished, draw and color a picture to go with it.



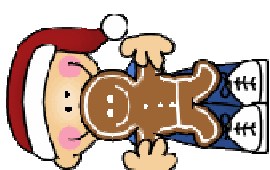
December Task Card #3

Use the December Word Wall Words to write a story. Circle each word you used when you are finished. After you are finished, draw and color a picture to go with it.



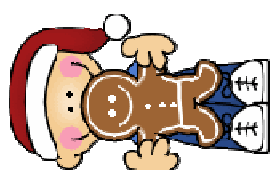
December Task Card #2

Write about how are candles used in your holiday celebrations? After you are finished, draw and color a picture to go with it.



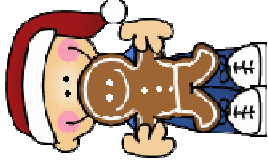
December Task Card #4

Write a letter to a loved one. Describe a gift you would like to give that person. Tell why you would like to give the gift to him or her.



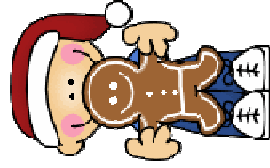
December Task Card #5

Pretend the gingerbread man was baked in your town. Write a story about his adventures. Use places around your town as the setting. Use people you know as the characters.



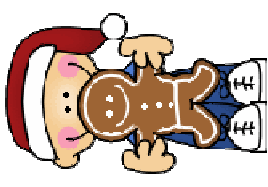
December Task Card #7

Write a letter to Santa Claus. After you are finished, draw and color a picture to go with it.



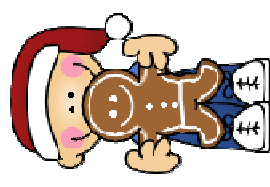
December Task Card #6

Would you rather have a long summer break or a long winter break? Why?



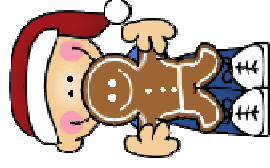
December Task Card #8

Write an acrostic poem using the word CHRISTMAS. After you are finished, draw and color a picture to go with it.



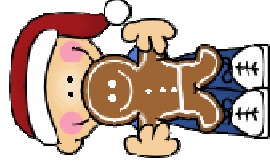
December Task Card #11
