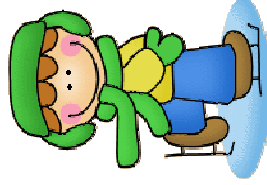


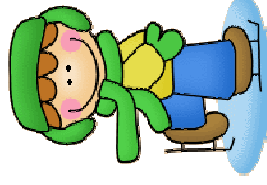
## January Task Card #1

Write an acrostic poem using the word JANUARY. After you are finished, draw and color a picture to go with it.



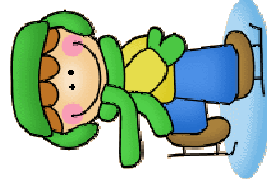
## January Task Card #2

Use the January Word Wall Words to write a story. Circle each word you used when you are finished. After you are finished, draw and color a picture to go with it.



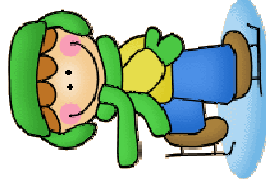
## January Task Card #4

Happy 2010! In ten years it will be 2020. What do you think your life will be like then?



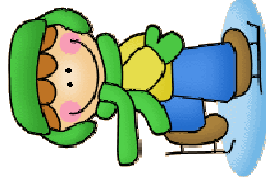
## January Task Card #5

Describe your favorite soup.



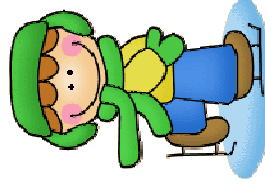
## January Task Card #6

in cold weather? Why?



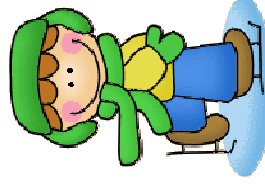
## January Task Card #7

peaceful place?



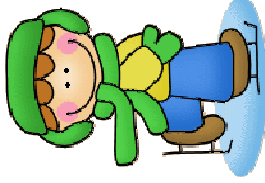
## January Task Card #8

make it happen?



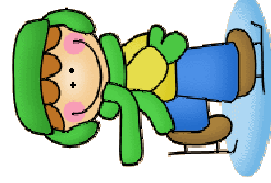
## January Task Card #9

When a new year begins, some people make promises to themselves to do better that year. What promise will you make to yourself to become a better student?



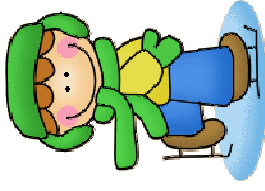
## January Task Card #11
