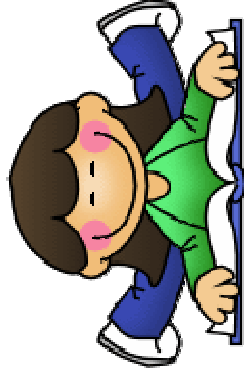


Thinkmarks
